		SCHOOL BUS COMPANY - Is this stop recommended by the School Bus Company?

		STOP LOCATION - Is stop at a corner or crossroads?
		Corner Location: SHARED STOP - Are we asking families to share a stop?
		Stop Location:
		VISIBILITY - Is the stop clearly visible from all directions for a minimum of 500 feet (approx. 150 metres)? (i.e.: flat road, no hills, curves or obstructions, etc.)
		PATH TO STOP - Is there a clear and safe path to the stop? (i.e.: wide shoulder on road,
		no water hazards, not required to cross busy road, etc.)
		WAITING AREA - Is there a safe place to wait for the bus? (i.e.: driveway, wide
		shoulder, etc.) Consider the number of students using the stop.
		 TURNAROUND - Is a turnaround suggested? If a turnaround is to occur in a driveway the residents must agree to keep the driveway clear of vehicles, snow, other obstructions, etc.
		The driveway must be wide enough for the bus to safely maneuver and there
		must not be hazards on either side of driveway (deep ditches, steep grade, etc.)
		Turnarounds must not occur if visibility is not clear (hill, curve, etc.)
KM		DISTANCE TO TURNAROUND - If a driveway turnaround is not available, what is the distance to a safe turnaround?
		POLICE - Is an evaluation by police personnel recommended?
