When checking the Safety of the Path to School, the following criteria are considered:

YES	NO	PATH TO SCHOOL – Is there a clear and safe path from the home to the School?
		Are there accessible Sidewalks along the Path to School?
		Wide Shoulder along the Road
		Small or No Shoulder along the Road
		High Traffic Volume
		High Traffic Speed (Special consideration is given to roads that have speed limits above 70 kph)
		Path to school requires students to cross busy Road(s)
		Traffic calming devices along Path to School – Lights, stop signs, cross walks, etc.
		Crossing Guards posted along Path to School
		Water Hazards
		Required to cross a Bridge without sidewalks or railings
		Unguarded railway crossings
		OTHER SAFETY CONCERNS -
		POLICE - Is an evaluation by police personnel recommended?
